(III) Selective courses 36 credits

1. The minimum professional selective courses are 16 credits.
2. Students are allowed to select 20-credit courses outside this department, including maximum 6-credit courses of General Education College as graduation credits (maximum 4-credit physical education course).
3. All-out National Defense Education Military Training course is excluded.

Notes :

1. Students shall keep this list as a reference to select and retake courses until graduation.
2. English Grammar and Writing (III) & (IV), English Oral Training (III) & (IV) and English Writing are divided into two groups when instructed.
3. In addition to completing all the required credits regulated by this department, day school students of this department shall achieve the testing standard of “English Competency” based on “The Implementation Guidance of Hungkuang University Department of English for Global Communication English Graduation Qualification”, and the regulation of “Information Competency” based on “The testing standard of Hungkuang University Department of English for Global Communication Information Competency”.
4. Students shall complete at least 720 hours of practicum during the second semester of senior.
5. Students shall at least complete one inter-departmental program during prescribed period to comply with one of the graduation essentials.
6. College core courses: “Introduction to Creativity”, “Consumer Psychology”, “Innovative Thinking and Application”, “Introduction to Management”.
7. When selecting and retaking courses, students of this department need to comply with “The Counseling Regulations of Hungkuang University Department of English for Global Communication Student Selecting Courses “.
