- 4. Students shall complete at least 720 hours of practicum during the second semester of senior.
- 5. Students shall at least complete one inter-departmental program during prescribed period to comply with one of the graduation essentials.
- College core courses: "Introduction to Creativity", "Consumer Psychology", "Innovative Thinking and Application", "Introduction to Management".
- 7. When selecting and retaking courses, students of this department need to comply with "The Counseling Regulations of Hungkuang University Department of English for Global Communication Student Selecting Courses".
