(III) Optional Course 38 credits

1. At least 18 credits of common electives and major electives are required.
2. This department allows 20 credits of elective courses from external departments, including elective courses offered by the General Education Center, which can accept up to 6 credits as graduation credits (physical education courses can accept up to 4 credits).
3. National defense education and military training are not included in the calculation of graduation credits.

Note :

1. Students are asked to keep this table properly until graduation. Each student will use the subject table as a reference for future course selection and retakes (make-up).
2. Courses such as "English Grammar and Writing", "English Oral Training" and "English Writing" are divided into two groups.
3. Computer course equipment required: Application Design.
4. In addition to completing the required credits stipulated by the department, students in the day department of this department must meet the testing standards of "Implementation Points for English Graduation Qualifications of the Department of English for Global Communication of Hungkuang University" and "Information Ability" must meet the requirements of the "Information Ability Test Standards of the Department of English for Global Communication of Hungkuang University" to be eligible for graduation.
5. Students should complete at least one cross-department course within the specified number of years to meet one of the graduation requirements.
6. Core courses of the college: "Introduction to Management", "Introduction to Creativity".
7. Course selection and retakes by students in this department must be handled in accordance with the relevant regulations of the "Course Selection and Guidance Measures for Students of the Department of English for Global Communication of Hungkuang University".
8. If you obtain the second specialty certificate, all the courses you take can be recognized as graduation credits.
9. In addition to completing the required credits for graduation, other graduation conditions must comply with the provisions of the school's academic regulations to be eligible for graduation.
